## 1 "Bad science" & misinformation

"It's very hard to sift through information that applies to the particular situation. A lot of bad 'science' is out there regarding Autism."

## 2 Limited rural information & services

"We live in a rural area 40 mins from a major city. Resources to connect with others with ASD or developmental disabilities are non-existent."

## 3 Limited adult information & services

"It is very hard to find resources/activities for higher functioning adults."

## 4 Limited school information & services

"The IEP process has been very hard to navigate through and find accurate and helpful information about what the process and entails."
